Instructions to Contributors (Revised June 2024)

Jahangirnagar University Journal of Science is a bi-annual multidisciplinary and advanced mathematical and physical science studies journal. The journal provides an international forum for discussion and debate for academic and practitioners to promote their blinded peer-reviewed works in scientific fields by publishing their manuscripts.

As an academic-oriented journal, the overall goal is to ensure that academics, regardless of their areas of specialization, are allowed to publish their novel research works at no fees.

To ensure the long-term recognition of authors, protection, and preservation of every article published in this journal, copies of the journal are archived and preserved regularly on the Jahangirnagar University Library website.

The journal welcomes contributions in all areas but not limited to including Mathematical Sciences, Physical Sciences, Geological Sciences, Computer Sciences and Environmental Sciences. The link to the journal is officially www.juniv.edu/faculty/science.

You are welcome to submit a paper to this online peer-reviewed journal.

You have to register yourself and then submit your article. The more you submit articles to the journal, there will be more visibility in the search engine. Manuscript should be submitted in English in the Jahangirnagar University Journal of Science style in A4 size paper (double space, New Times Roman, font size 12. In case of co-author(s) from outside Jahangirnagar University a written consent of such co-author(s) should accompany the manuscript.

The name, institutional affiliation, complete mailing address, telephone number, e-mail of the corresponding author to whom proofs and reprints of the paper are to be sent should be clearly stated on the title page. No new material may be introduced at the proof-reading stage.

A short abstract of about 200 words must be included at the beginning of the manuscript together with 5 or 6 keywords or phrases other than those included in the title to describe the content of the paper. Mathematical expression or any kind of symbol should be avoided in the title and abstract as far as possible.

Illustrations, tables and figures should appear in the document near where they are referenced in the text. Large tables or figures should be put on pages by themselves. All illustrations (figures and tables) must be clearly numbered and referred to sequentially in the text.

References should be numbered, within third brackets, in order of their appropriate positions in the text (for example [1]). However, all the references of the manuscript should be typed in their serial order in the text under the heading "References".
